THINKING OF VOLUNTEERING?

HART Services has a great team of volunteers who make a real difference in the life of our Clients. Volunteers are at the heart of our service and through their generous gift of time they enable a better quality of life for others.



VOLUNTEER POSITIONS?

We have different volunteer roles:

- >> Individual transport; driving elderly and younger people with disability to medical appointments.
- >> Assisting on buses and group outings.
- >> Social Support volunteers offer accompanied shopping, outings and friendly home visiting (Lismore area)
- >> Aboriginal Transport Program Community Bus Drivers, transporting community members to a range of outings

MEDICAL TRANSPORT DRIVERS

It is up to each driver how often they drive. Some drivers drive on a particular day each week, others offer occasional driving.

HART Services provides local transport as well as long distance individual trips, the driver determines if they are available for long distance trips e.g. the Gold Coast or Brisbane or would prefer only local trips.

HART Services has a range of fleet vehicles, predominately Ford Mondeo wagons. When drivers do use their own vehicles they are reimbursed for fuel.

SOCIAL SUPPORT

VOLUNTEERS

Social Support volunteering is on a one to one basis and may involve offering practical assistance to those in our community who are socially isolated e.g taking a person out on a social activity such as morning tea, lunch, shopping, banking or other appointments.

It may involve just spending time visiting a person in their own home, providing companionship or helping them to write a letter.

GROUP SERVICES

We provide both Social and Shopping Bus services and have volunteer roles for Bus Drivers and Client Assistants.

Some outings are fortnightly while others once a month. So if you have some time to spare on that basis we would love to hear from you!

Shopping buses operate in Casino, Coraki, Lismore & Kyogle.

Social Outings are great fun and include activities such as:

Mixed social outings, Women's outings, Men's outings, Carers outings and shorter outings for those who may have difficulty with a full day.

ABORIGINAL COMMUNITY

TRANSPORT BUS DRIVERS

As a volunteer Aboriginal community bus driver you can give something back to your community by transporting:

- >> community members to an array of outings, social events and most importantly Elders outings,
- >> youth after school and on weekends to sporting and youth events.

The more volunteer bus drivers each community has, means the buses are available and ready to be used more regularly.

It's about making a difference! and having a positive impact in communities.

The community buses are often the only public transport available as communities are situated in isolated and remote areas.

Become a volunteer community bus driver and make a real difference in people's lives!
